President Tsai amnestied Wang Guang Lu, who convicted of using a modified firearm to hunt protected animals and violating Controlling Guns, Ammunition and Knives Act and Wildlife Conservation Act.

Here is an explanation of Taiwan Taitung District Prosecutors Office as follow:

1. President Tsai granted an official pardon for Wang Guang Lu (also known as Tama Talum), an indigenous Bunun man, convicted of using a modified firearm to hunt protected animals, and sentenced to 3 years and 6 months of imprisonment of the execution, including of 3 years and 2 months of imprisonment for violating Controlling Guns, Ammunition and Knives Act, and 7 months of imprisonment for violating Wildlife Conservation Act, after The Supreme Court overruled the extraordinary appeal of The Supreme Prosecutors Office on October 29, 2015.
2. After President Tsai amnestied Wang Guang Lu, Wang Guang Lu also received the certification of the amnesty from The Ministry of Justice at 2:30 p.m. this afternoon, with epidemic prevention measures.
3. Taiwan Taitung District Prosecutors Office will be in accordance with the official pardon and the instruction of The Ministry of Justice, and will also exempt the execution of Wang Guang Lu, which is pursuant to the preceding paragraph of Article 3 of the Pardon Law.
